






WHEREAS, GMHA recognizes that all Clinical Technicians in the Nursing and Professional Support Divisions, as with all its employees, are valued and appreciated. GMHA further recognizes that said Clinical Technicians have yet to receive a working differential; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 Nurse Pay Plan and Structure Differential (the 2021 NPPSD) implemented and effective August 1, 2021 has increased the wages of the licensed and certified nursing staff to be comparable to the national average; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2021 Board of Trustees Official Resolution No. 2021-54 granted a 25% working differential for certified or licensed GMHA employees in Medical Laboratory Science and Respiratory Therapy in order to augment wages to be comparable to the national average; and

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2021 Board of Trustees Official Resolution No. 2022-06 granted a 25% working differential for certified or licensed GMHA employees in Rehabilitation, Radiology, Dietary, and Special Services in order to augment wages to be comparable to the national average; and

WHEREAS, the latest 2022 data average from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics shows a national mean wage for Clinical Technicians at \$22.07 per hour (\$45,905 per annum); and

WHEREAS, the actual (as of May 2022) mean wage of GMHA Clinical Technicians is \$12.70 per hour (\$26,416 per annum); and

WHEREAS, the current 2014 Competitive Wage Act implementing the current Government of Guam pay plans authorized for use by the GMHA are based on a fourteen (14) year old wage study conducted by the Hay Group in 2008; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 4GCA §6303. Compensation Policy (c), “Internal equity should be reviewed annually and external competitiveness at least every 3 years”; and

RESOLVED, that the Board has determined it is in the best interest of the GMHA to extend a 15% working differential to all GMHA Clinical Technicians in the Nursing and Professional Support Divisions to augment wages to be competitive with the national average; and be it further

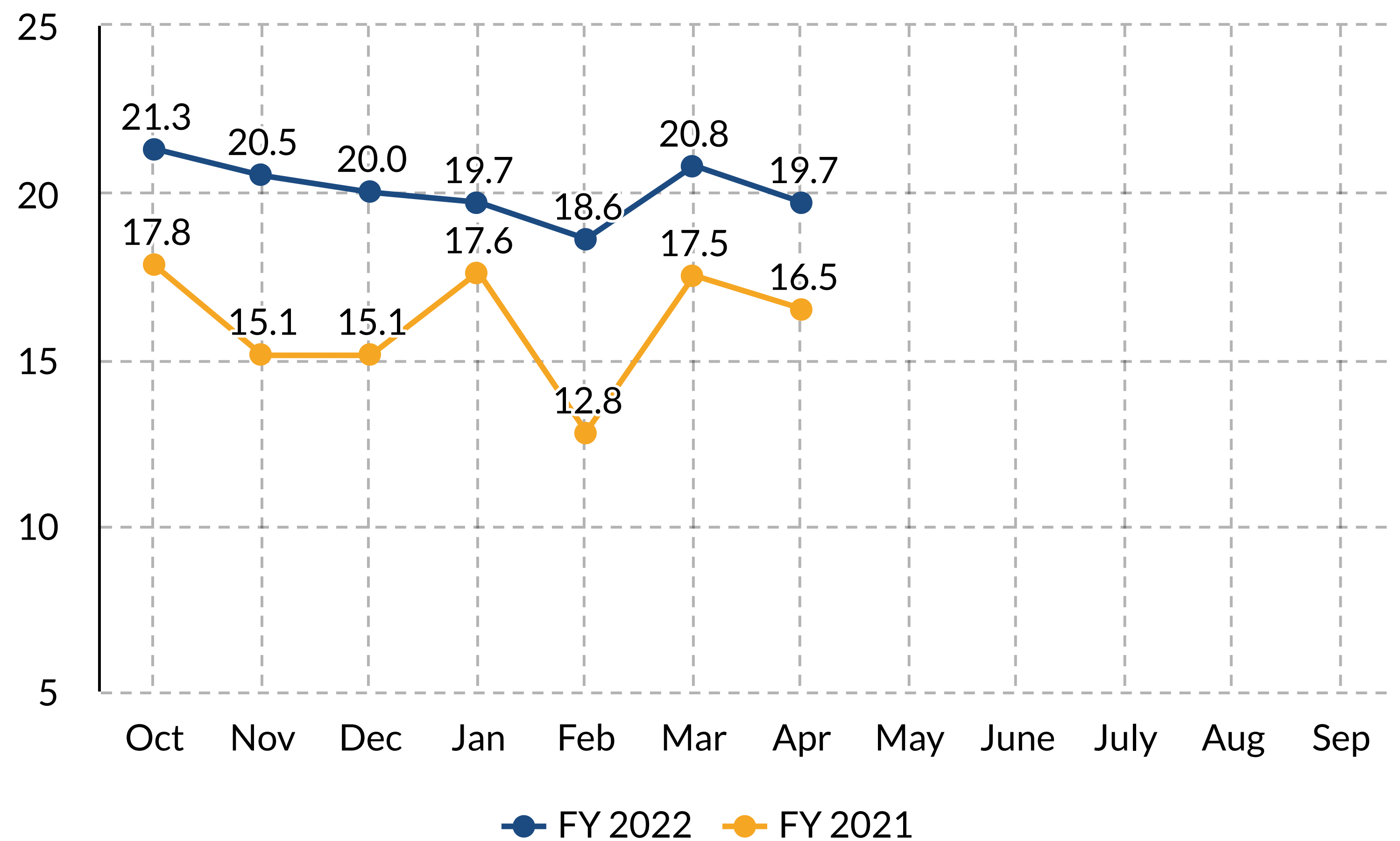

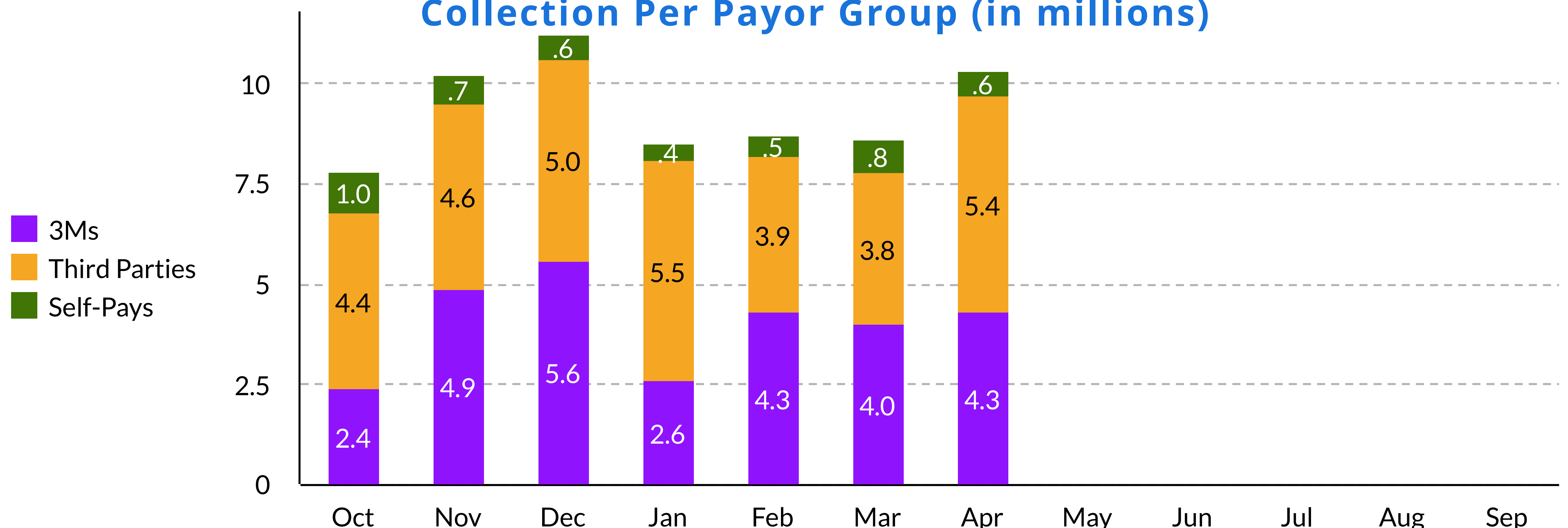

US Air Force: Weekend testing of hypersonic weapon was a success

WASHINGTON (Reuters) – The U.S. Air Force said Monday it had conducted a successful test of a hypersonic weapon, which flew at five times the speed of sound.

The test was conducted Saturday off the coast of Southern California when a B-52 bomber released an Air-launched Rapid Response Weapon, the Air Force said in a statement.

"Following separation from the aircraft, the ARRW's booster ignited and burned for expected duration, achieving hypersonic speeds five times greater than the speed of sound," it said.

The United States is not alone in developing hypersonic weapons, whose speed and maneuverability make them difficult to track and intercept.

Russia has fired hypersonic missiles at targets in Ukraine and China has tested hypersonic weapons, U.S. military officials have said. China's foreign ministry denied in October that it had conducted a weapons test.

NKorea deploys army, health workers as COVID-19 surges

SEOUL (Reuters) — North Korea has mobilized its military to distribute COVID-19 medications and deployed more than 10,000 health workers to help trace potential patients as it fights a sweeping coronavirus wave, state media KCNA said Tuesday.

The isolated country is grappling with its first acknowledged COVID-19 outbreak, which it confirmed last week, fueling concerns over a major crisis due to a lack of vaccines and adequate medical infrastructure.

The state emergency epidemic prevention headquarters reported 269,510 more people with fever symptoms, bringing the total to 1,483,060, while the death toll grew to 56 as of Monday evening, KCNA said. It did not say how many people have tested positive for COVID-19.

"A powerful force" of the army's medical corps was immediately deployed to improve the supply of medicines in the capital Pyongyang, the center of the epidemic, follow-

ing an order by leader Kim Jong Un, KCNA reported.

The team's mission was aimed at "defusing the public health crisis" in Pyongyang, it said.

Some senior members of the ruling Workers' Party's powerful politburo visited pharmacies and medicine management offices to check supply and demand, KCNA said in another dispatch, after Kim criticized ineffec-

tive distribution of drugs.

"They called for establishing a more strict order in keeping and handling the medical supplies, maintaining the principle of prioritizing the demand and convenience of the people in the supply," KCNA said.

Tracing efforts were also intensified, with some 11,000 health officials, teachers and medical students joining an "intensive medical examination of all inhabitants" across the country to locate and treat people with fever.

Still, various sectors of the national economy are maintaining production and construction, while taking thorough anti-virus measures, KCNA added. Kim had ordered that limited activity be allowed in each city and country.

The World Health Organization has warned the virus may spread rapidly in North Korea, which had no vaccination program and declined international help.

Biden weighs meeting with Saudi ruler

(Bloomberg) – President Joe Biden is weighing a meeting with Saudi Arabia's Mohammed bin Salman as soon as next month, according to people familiar with the matter, after avoiding contact with the crown prince over the murder of columnist Jamal Khashoggi.

The move will mark a significant shift for Biden. Early in his presidency, the White House had said that Biden would deal only with Saudi Arabia's official head of state, King Salman bin Abdulaziz. An administration official, who asked not to be identified because of the sensitivity of the matter, said Biden may visit the Middle East for meetings with the Gulf Cooperation Council, a regional political and economic union, and noted that Saudi Arabia currently holds the presidency of the group.

At stake is a decades-old partnership that's given the U.S. clout in the world's

top energy-exporting region. Spiraling U.S. gasoline prices have raised pressure on Biden to make amends with the prince because he effectively controls the levers of power in the kingdom. King Salman, 86, left hospital earlier this week after treatment and recovery that included a colonoscopy.

The people familiar with the matter

asked not to be identified because a meeting in the world's largest oil exporter remains under discussion. CNN reported earlier that planning was underway for a meeting between Biden and MBS.

The slaying and dismemberment of Khashoggi, a U.S. resident and Washington Post columnist, in the Saudi consulate in Istanbul in 2018 deeply damaged the kingdom's relations with the U.S. government. Soon after he took office, Biden's administration released a declassified report pinning blame for the murder on the crown prince.

The prince has denied any involvement, though he's said he accepts responsibility for the killing as Saudi Arabia's de facto ruler.


A spokeswoman for the White House National Security Council said they have no travel to announce at this time. Saudi Arabia's Center for International Communication, and the

Saudi Embassy in Washington, didn't respond to requests for comment.

International consumers have called on Saudi Arabia and its partners to fill the gap left by a boycott of Russian crude over Moscow's war on Ukraine and help ease the inflationary pain caused by prices near \$110 a barrel. Saudi Arabia is a heavyweight in OPEC+, a powerful alliance between the oil-exporters' cartel and Russia.

A visit would increase the probability that OPEC+ could pump more oil, Bob McNally, president of Washington-based consultant Rapidan Energy Group, said.

Biden has been reluctantly drawn into closer ties with Saudi Arabia's king-in-waiting, Bloomberg reported in March, forced by Russia's invasion of Ukraine to rethink a standoffish approach amid a shifting geopolitical landscape with China an increasingly assertive superpower.
