As of today, the numbers have climbed with an additional \$7 million for two chillers that need to be replaced accompanied by cooling towers. 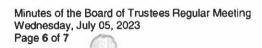

During Supertyphoon Mawar the hospital was bombarded with individuals from the Community needing treatment due to Renal Dialysis Clinics having no Power and Water issues. The Outpatient Community Clinics have now reopened, and we are no longer servicing those individuals.

	Board of Trustees to Write Off \$3.2 million in uncollectable debts owed on some old accounts, dating as far back as 17 years. The most recent accounts especially those that we see movement on will be kept active. The following are just some of the reasons. No collection efforts made to account. EOB not timely posted and were not closed. Missed billing timeline. In knowing all these, this will help improve our process and workflows, as well as ourselves. Collection efforts have been unsuccessful, most of the patient contact numbers are not in service or have changed. Trustee Davis recommends improvement to patient intake upon arrival. Ensure that staff are trained properly in obtaining patient information and records are filled out and complete. In doing so, this will help with collectability. Chairwoman Obispo questioned whether or not the Write-Off still limits us from collecting if the patient was to come into the hospital. Ms. Hechanova responded that we can still collect, it just would not be on the aging report. It will be collected as a miscellaneous revenue.
