	<p>Dr. Ricardo Eusebio provided an update on the interim CEO priorities, which remain focused on stabilization, operational readiness, fiscal stewardship, and preparing the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority for long-term transformation.</p> <p>1. <u>Visible Stabilization and Facility Integrity</u></p> <p>The hospital is actively implementing roof and building envelope improvements, along with exterior repairs addressing cracking and weather-related exposure. As repairs are completed, the affected areas are being repainted to protect surfaces and restore the hospital environment.</p> <p>Recent work has included exterior preparation and repairs in key areas, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ICU • CME area • Pediatrics • Medical Telemetry <p>Upcoming exterior phases will focus on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The rear extension of the Emergency Department • Back areas of the Med-Surg and Surgical units <p>Dr. Eusebio emphasized that these efforts are not cosmetic in nature, but part of a broader roof and building envelope</p>	Acting Interim Hospital Administrator/CEO - Ricardo Eusebio, MD	None	Informational

	<p>revitalization initiative intended to reduce water intrusion risk and improve facility resilience and service continuity.</p> <p>In parallel, the hospital is improving the environment of care through focused cleaning and upkeep. Environmental Services has completed stripping and waxing of floors in operating room spaces and several ICU rooms, and continues scheduled floor care across additional patient care areas. Expectations around daily cleanliness standards and sustained upkeep are also being reinforced.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>2.
