

JAM Session 15:

One Wipe or Two? Using GMHA Disinfectants the **RIGHT** Way

START HERE: It's NOT About the Number of Wipes

It's About:

- What you see (clean vs dirty)
- The product you're using (follow Instructions for Use—IFU)
- Keeping it **wet** for the **FULL** contact time

STEP 1: LOOK FIRST

Is there visible soil (blood, body fluids, dirty)?

IF VISIBLE SOIL (DIRTY)

ALWAYS CLEAN FIRST -> THEN DISINFECT

- ◆ Remove visible soil using wipe/cloth
- ◆ Then apply disinfectant

Applies to ALL GMHA Products:

- HB Quat spray
- TB_Cide spray
- Bleach spray
- All wipes

! Disinfectant does NOT work through dirt!

IF NO VISIBLE SOIL (CLEAN) -> Use product as directed (one-step allowed if IFU supports it)

DISINFECTANTS— QUICK GUIDE-WIPES

(One-Step When Surface is Clean)

- Red Top (PDI Sani-Cloth Plus) -> 3 min
- Gray Top (AF3) (Super Sani-Cloth) -> 3 min
- Purple Top (Super Sani-Cloth) -> 2 min
- Clorox Bleach Wipes -> 3 min
- Use ONE wipe if clean, Ensure surface stays WET full contact time.

QUICK GUIDE- SPRAYS

- HB Quat spray -> 10min
- TB-Cide Quat Spray-> 10min
- Bleach Spray (1:10) -> 10min

Steps:

- Spray surface thoroughly
- Wipe to spread evenly (if needed)
- Keep surface **WET** for full 10 minutes

CONTACT TIME = DISINFECTION

- If it dries early -> **! NOT Disinfected**
- Reapply to keep surface wet

HOW TO CLEAN (when using ALL disinfectants)

- Use firm friction
- Cover: Front/back, Sides, Buttons, Edges / Seams

COMMON MISTAKES

- Using disinfectant on dirty surface without cleaning first
- Not following contact time
- "Quick wipe and go"
- Thinking more wipes means better

KEY MESSAGE:

Dirty? Clean THEN disinfect.

Clean? Use the product correctly and keep it wet.
