HEALTHY VISITS HELP PROTECT HEALTHY PATIENTS.

### PLEASE DO NOT VISIT IF YOU HAVE:

- Fever
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Rash
- Flu-like symptoms

Even “just allergies” or “a little cold” may place patients at risk.

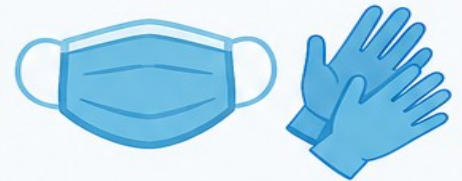
### CLEAN HANDS SAVE LIVES



#### Visitors should:

- ✓ Clean hands when entering the facility
- ✓ Clean hands before and after visiting a patient
- ✓ Use sanitizer or soap and water

### FOLLOW ISOLATION PRECAUTIONS



- ✓ Follow posted instructions
- ✓ Wear PPE correctly
- ✓ Ask staff if unsure
- ✓ Do not enter restricted rooms without guidance

### HELP KEEP PATIENTS SAFE

- Avoid sitting on patient beds
- Avoid touching medical equipment
- Avoid visiting multiple patients
- Avoid bringing young children

Kindly educate and guide visitors when needed. A respectful reminder can help prevent infection transmission.
