This amendment is in response to clarifications submitted to Materials Management.

Received from Vet-Blue LLC in Partnership with Guam Cleaning Masters

Question: Whether the mandatory designation of the April 6, 2026 site visit remains in effect.

Response: Page 2 of the RFP packet is hereby amended to remove “mandatory” from the April 6, 2026 site visit.

Question: Whether prospective offerors who did not attend the April 6, 2026 mandatory site visit are eligible to submit a proposal for this RFP.

Response: Yes, all prospective offerors will be allowed to submit a proposal for this RFP, regardless of their attendance of the site visits.

Question: If GMHA intends to permit such offerors to submit proposals, whether GMHA will issue a formal amendment documenting the waiver of the mandatory site visit requirement so that all offerors and the public record reflect the change in eligibility rules.

Response: In the interest of maximizing competition, the RFP is hereby amended to remove “mandatory” from all site visits.

Question: What is the basis for scheduling a second visit after completion of the original mandatory site visit?

Response: In the interest of maximizing competition and providing additional opportunity for participation, a second site visit was scheduled.
