GMHA Breaks Ground on Roof and Envelope Restoration Initiative

Project strengthens hospital's structure and safety for patients and staff

(Wednesday, November 12, 2025; Tamuning, Guam) The Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) today held a groundbreaking ceremony for its Roof and Envelope Restoration Initiative, a major capital improvement project that will harden the hospital's structure and enhance safety for patients and staff.

The project includes upgrades to the hospital's roof and exterior walls across all four floors, the replacement of typhoon shutters, and various structural improvements designed to fortify the building against Guam's weather conditions.

GMHA Interim Administrator Dr. Joleen M. Aguon said the project represents another important step forward in the hospital's revitalization efforts.

"This groundbreaking marks another milestone in strengthening our hospital, not just for today, but for generations to come," said Dr. Aguon. "Alongside other recent improvements like our new chillers and the parking lot project, this initiative shows real, visible progress. We are not only restoring a building. We are restoring hope, trust, and strength in Guam's public hospital. Because this is *Our Hospital, Our Mission, and Our Island.*"

Governor Lou Leon Guerrero commended GMHA for its continued progress in improving its infrastructure and services, while reinforcing the administration's long-term vision for healthcare on Guam.
