## GMHA Honors Excellence in Nursing at Inaugural DAISY Award Ceremony

**(Tuesday, November 18, 2025; Tamuning, Guam)** The Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) hosted its inaugural DAISY Award Ceremony, recognizing 33 exemplary nurses whose compassion, dedication, and skill have left lasting impressions on the patients and families they serve. The ceremony also honored Danica Dianzon, Hospital Staff Nurse I – Clinical Level II of the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), as GMHA's first DAISY Award honoree.

"Our nurses bring compassion, calm, and comfort into some of the hardest moments our patients and families face. The small acts of kindness and strength you show every day may go unseen, but they matter deeply," Dr. Joleen M. Aguon, Interim CEO and Administrator, said. "Today's nominees were remembered because someone felt truly cared for. That is powerful. The DAISY Award provides patients, families, and colleagues the opportunity to honor nurses who consistently deliver compassionate and skillful care. GMHA's inaugural honoree, Danica Dianzon, began her nursing career at the hospital last year in the ICU. A 2024 graduate of the University of Guam, she completed her ICU residency before joining the team full-time. Dianzon is admired by her peers and leaders for her positive attitude, her eagerness to take on challenges, and the kindness she brings to every interaction.

"I'm overwhelmed and grateful for everybody who helped me get this award," Dianzon shared. "I just started last year, and being in the ICU isn't always easy. It takes the whole team. They have helped me grow and get here. Thank you."
