GMHA Continues Revitalization Efforts With Support From Community Partners

(Tamuning, Guam; January 20, 2026) — The Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) continues to advance revitalization efforts across the hospital campus, with recent progress focused on improving patient care environments and shared spaces, made possible through the support of dedicated community partners who volunteered their time to assist the hospital.

Over the weekend, volunteers from the Chålan Åmte Group and the Guam Fire Department joined GMHA's Facilities Maintenance personnel to assist with exterior beautification, painting, and grounds work around the hospital. Their efforts supported ongoing revitalization activities aimed at improving safety, accessibility, and the overall experience for patients, families, and staff.

Inside the hospital, volunteers from the Serve Guam Commission and the AmeriCorps Program worked alongside GMHA teams to support interior upkeep efforts that help maintain clean, respectful spaces for patient care and daily operations.

“These efforts reflect the heart of our community and the shared responsibility we all have for the place that cares for our island,” said GMHA Interim Chief Executive Officer and Administrator Dr. Joleen M. As part of this work, GMHA’s Environmental Services team continued targeted efforts in priority clinical areas, focusing on patient rooms and care-related spaces within the Intensive Care Unit. This work supports patient safety and helps ensure clinical environments remain ready to support care delivery.
